Using car care products from Porsche Tequipment.

Weather and environmental conditions take their toll on the exterior and interior of your Porsche, day after day. The right car care with the appropriate products can help you prevent this wear and tear.

The car care products from Porsche Tequipment have been specially developed for Porsche vehicles and optimally coordinated. The exterior cleaning and care products, for example, help maintain the perfect appearance of your Porsche. They remove dirt such as insect residue on the front apron, pollen on the windscreen and impurities on the paintwork. Porsche Tequipment also offers high-quality cleaning and care products for the interior, which protect the natural leather material against heat and UV rays and stop it from drying out. The highly effective agents penetrate

deep into the leather, thereby preserving its natural suppleness and preventing cracking.

All the products in the range have been tested in Weissach – by the same engineers who develop the cars, thereby reflecting the consistently high quality of the Porsche brand.

## Car care case

**Perfect for our products,  
your Porsche and your next adventure.**

Porsche Tequipment has developed a car care range that offers a wide selection of products for protecting and maintaining your vehicle. This special White Edition is presented in a high-quality Rimowa trolley case, providing stylish, compact storage for all the products. It fits every Porsche model, is sturdy and ultra-light and has four multi-directional wheels, as well as a recessed TSA lock. The foam inlay can be removed if necessary, allowing the trolley case to be used as an ideal travel accessory.

Also typical of Porsche Tequipment is the unique design of all the bottles. Developed together with the designers from Studio F.A. Porsche, it is timeless and inspired by the shape of the Porsche Crest. Special cars deserve special attention.



# Alloy wheel cleaner

Perfect care starts from the bottom up.

The wheels of your Porsche are extremely hard-wearing. They resist heat and cold, transfer power and also have to withstand chemical contaminants such as dirt and brake dust. As a result, stubborn deposits often form on the exterior surfaces of the alloy wheels. Which is precisely why regular, gentle cleaning with the right equipment will significantly help to retain the value of the alloys.

The Porsche alloy wheel cleaner and three-piece brush set are both effective and extremely easy to use. Previously, stubborn stains could only be removed using acidic cleaning agents. But these react not only with brake dust, but also with all other materials. This poses a risk to health and materials (corrosion on brake discs and hoses, wheel nuts, paint, etc.), so acidic alloy wheel cleaner cannot be safely used. Porsche alloy wheel cleaner is completely acid-free and contains very special ingredients that are perfectly suited to brake wear and tear. It eliminates this extremely efficiently and is also gentle on all materials. Thanks to the gel formula, the cleaner has particularly good adhesive properties and is therefore ideal for use before visiting the car-wash.

## Directions for use:

1. Spray the wheels with Porsche alloy wheel cleaner before washing or using the car-wash.
2. Leave to work for three to five minutes – in case of extreme soiling or temperatures below 10° C, leave to work for max. 10 minutes.
3. Thoroughly cleanse the wheels using a powerful jet of water and/or drive through the car-wash.
4. Use the three-piece brush set on stubborn stains, so that even difficult-to-reach areas are gently and thoroughly cleaned. Simply screw the required brush attachment onto the handle.

## NB:

- Do not apply in direct sunlight or to hot surfaces.
- Please only use the genuine spray gun.
- Do not apply to unprotected, highly-polished alloy wheels.



## Insect remover

**Ahead of you: the road.  
And an uninterrupted view.**

What's the most beautiful thing for any Porsche driver? The uninterrupted view from the cockpit. This shouldn't be spoiled by insect residue and dirt on the screen. Because smear-free vision is an important safety aspect. If dirt particles are not removed, they can also permanently damage the paintwork of your Porsche.

Use the acid-free, gel-based insect remover to effortlessly and spotlessly remove insect residue. Without damaging the glass or paint, of course.

### **Directions for use:**

1. Spray the windscreen or front of the vehicle before driving through the car-wash or washing by hand.
2. Then wipe with a sponge and rinse thoroughly with water.

### **NB:**

- Do not apply in direct sunlight or to hot surfaces.
- Porsche insect remover is also suitable for removing insects from the front of the car.

## Interior glass cleaner

**A clear view also comes from within.**

Unimpeded external visibility can definitely also be obscured from the inside, as a result of dust, impurities and various dirt particles in the air. These settle on the inside of the window, where they often form stubborn residue. This impairs your external view. An unnecessary safety risk that can easily be avoided by using interior glass cleaner.

After use, you can look forward to crystal-clear windows and a smear-free view. And to uninterrupted vistas.

### **Directions for use:**

1. Give the windows a good spray.
2. Then wipe the windows in sections using the soft, clean microfibre cloth, taking care to remove any smears.

### **NB:**

- Do not apply in direct sunlight or to hot surfaces.





# Shampoo and convertible top cleaner

## The washing procedure – a clean affair.

Whether paintwork or cabriolet hood: both components are exposed to the same severe weather conditions. Use Porsche shampoo and convertible top cleaner to gently clean your car, with or without a convertible hood. This process forms the basis for all other cleaning work. Because road dust, oil residue, etc. can quickly damage the paintwork. They also form a layer of dirt that can scratch the paintwork during direct polishing without any pre-treatment. Hard tap water with no special additives is also too aggressive and often leaves water stains.

Regular cleaning is the first step towards a permanently attractive appearance and the long-term preservation of your vehicle. Impurities are removed and the surface optimally prepared for subsequent paint polish and wax sealing. Use a fine sponge and soft cloths to avoid superficial scratches, gently clean the paintwork and preserve any wax and protective layers.

### Directions for use:

1. Remove the worst of the dirt using plenty of water.
2. Add shampoo and convertible top cleaner to the water at a ratio of one cap per five litres of water (in case of extreme soiling and to clean the convertible hood, use two caps per five litres of water).
3. Wash your car from top to bottom using the Porsche sponge. Wash the lower third last. This significantly reduces scratching. We recommend cleaning the convertible hood using the Porsche sponge or a soft brush.
4. Remember to clean the inside edges of the doors and sill guards, as this is where water and dirt always accumulate.
5. After washing, rinse the car with plenty of clean water, to prevent any water droplets. It's best to use a hosepipe without a spray head for this.
6. Dry any residual moisture using the clean chamois leather. When drying the vehicle, please ensure that the chamois leather does not touch the ground, as it can absorb sand or dirt, which could leave scratches.

### NB:

- Before starting, make sure the lighting conditions are good and do not undertake the washing procedure in direct sunlight or on hot surfaces.
- Do not use a natural sponge, as grains of sand or similar harmful particles risk becoming stuck within the structure of the sponge and may cause scratches, when applying pressure, for example.



## Paint polish

**Highlights – can also be added during care.**

Immaculately maintained paintwork and glossy colours primarily contribute to the appearance of your Porsche and leave a lasting impression. UV rays, rain, industrial dust and other environmental factors have a recurring impact on the paintwork, which can only permanently withstand these influences by means of regular care. If you discover scratches in the paint or its deep gloss finish visibly fades, polish the car without delay using Porsche paint polish. Compared to conventional products, you'll be impressed by the lustrous effect achieved. Care that ensures the perfect appearance and long-term preservation of your vehicle.

Porsche paint polish contains special abrasive particles, allowing you to easily remove haze and superficial scratches. We recommend one to two applications per year.

### **Directions for use:**

1. In preparation for the treatment, wash your car using the Porsche shampoo and convertible top cleaner.
2. Shake the Porsche paint polish before use.
3. Apply the paint polish to the paintwork with the pressed sponge, using equal pressure and small circular movements. Always work on a small area of approx. 50 × 50cm.
4. Allow the polish to briefly dry, until a light grey film appears on the paint, and polish the area to a high gloss using the microfibre cloth provided, which should be frequently turned.
5. For follow-up treatment and the long-term protection of the paintwork, we recommend treating with Porsche hard wax.

### **NB:**

- First wash your car using the Porsche shampoo and convertible top cleaner.
- Do not cover painted plastic surfaces before polishing. Otherwise, the paint polish may leave white edges on the plastic or change its colour.
- Do not apply the paint polish in direct sunlight or to hot surfaces. Do not apply to chrome surfaces, such as car emblems, for example.
- Ensure your work area is clean and well lit.
- We recommend proceeding in sections from top to bottom, i.e. starting with the roof, via the bonnet lid and tailgate, to the doors and wings.
- Store the paint polish in a frost-proof place.



# Hard wax

The perfect finish on the home straight.

Solar radiation bleaches paintwork over time. It becomes unsightly and must be constantly protected against harmful environmental effects, such as UV rays, rain, insects, etc. Once polished, paintwork should therefore be sealed and finished using a high-quality hard wax. Which is why we've created an extremely hard wax bearing its own signature touch.

Porsche hard wax combines perfect protection and ease of use, shielding both new and polished paintwork from the effects of the weather. When using it, you'll be impressed by the natural, delicate texture of the wax. It contains high-quality Brazilian Carnauba wax (the hardest natural wax) and special nano-polymers. This ensures a beautiful shine, long-term protection with a stain-resistant effect with excellent repellent properties. Before applying the wax to your vehicle, clean the paintwork using the shampoo and convertible top cleaner. Depending on the condition of the paintwork, you can also polish your car using the Porsche polish.



## Directions for use:

1. Clean the car using the Porsche shampoo and convertible top cleaner. Depending on the condition of the paintwork, polish using the Porsche paint polish before applying wax.
2. Thinly and evenly apply the Porsche hard wax to the dry paintwork with circular movements using the Porsche pad. Treat an area of approx. 50 × 50cm at a time.
3. Leave the wax film to completely dry.
4. Evenly polish the area with gentle circular movements using the microfibre cloth, which should be frequently turned.

## NB:

- Make sure the lighting is good; for perfect results, use a mobile lamp.
- Avoid applying wax in sunlight or to hot surfaces.
- Ensure your work area is clean, preferably in a garage or workshop.
- We recommend proceeding in sections from top to bottom, i.e. starting with the roof, via the bonnet lid and tailgate, to the doors and wings.
- Do not apply wax to plastic surfaces. Unintentionally applied Porsche hard wax must be removed immediately, using a dry, absorbent cloth.
- We recommend applying wax after every polish using Porsche paint polish and/or at least twice a year.
- Store the bottle in a frost-proof place.



## Leather cleaner

**Surface cleaning can also be in-depth.**

Dirt impairs the elegant appearance of any leather interior. It penetrates the natural fibre structure of the leather, drying out the fabric. The leather therefore becomes brittle and cracked. Porsche leather cleaner thoroughly removes dirt and stains, without altering the original colour. The surface of the leather is therefore optimally prepared for subsequent treatment with leather conditioner.

### Directions for use:

1. Soak the sponge with handle supplied, or a clean, soft and lint-free cloth, with leather cleaner.
2. Clean the leather surfaces and wipe with a damp cloth or sponge, before subsequently treating with the Porsche leather conditioner.

### NB:

- Do not apply in direct sunlight or to hot surfaces.
- Do not apply to plastic or painted surfaces. Remove any unintentionally applied leather cleaner immediately, using an absorbent cloth.

## Leather conditioner

**Elegant material requires opulent care.**

High-quality leather requires first-class care. Because environmental factors such as heat, UV rays and dirt dry out the natural material. Porsche leather conditioner contains high-quality jojoba oil that permanently protects against ageing and cracking. The highly effective conditioning agents penetrate deep into the leather, thereby preserving its natural suppleness. Special sunscreen additives prevent bleaching as a result of UV rays.

### Directions for use:

1. Shake the bottle before use.
2. Evenly and sparingly apply the Porsche leather conditioner to clean, dry surfaces, using the sponge with handle supplied.
3. Leave the leather conditioner to work depending on the absorbency of the leather and then polish using the terry towel or a soft brush.

### NB:

- Do not apply in direct sunlight or to hot surfaces.
- Store tightly closed in a frost-proof place.
